

## Common Instrument Suite – Educator (CIS-E) Sample Questions and Items

The Common Instrument Suite Educator Survey (CIS-E) is a retrospective self-report survey designed to capture the unique qualities of STEM programs and the practitioners who lead them. Developed to complement both the Common Instrument Suite-Student (CIS-S) and the Dimensions of Success Observation Tool (DoS), the CIS-E enables programs to capture key information about who is leading STEM activities, educators' levels of support, and perceived efficacy in delivering STEM content. The survey was designed for any in- and out-of-school time staff leading or co-leading STEM activities.

Section	Sample Questions/Items
Qualities of School/Program	<ul> <li>Which topics are taught in your school/program?</li> <li>Which grade groups does your school/program engage in STEM activities?</li> </ul>
Engagement of Youth in STEM	<ul> <li>Did you/your program provide any home-based/online STEM learning opportunities to youth?</li> <li>Approximately how many weeks did you engage learners in STEM activities?</li> </ul>
Educator Identity/Background	<ul><li>What is the highest level of education that you have completed?</li><li>Which gender do you most identify with?</li></ul>
Experience Leading STEM	<ul> <li>What is your primary role in the school/program?</li> <li>How many total years of experience do you have leading in-school STEM activities?</li> </ul>
Educator Interest/Confidence in STEM	<ul> <li>I think of myself as a STEM person.</li> <li>My friends/colleagues think of me as a STEM person.</li> <li>I am comfortable with leading STEM activities.</li> <li>I am interested in leading STEM activities.</li> </ul>
Ease of Implementing DoS-aligned Practices	<ul> <li>How easy or hard is it for you to engage in the following practices?</li> <li>Ensuring all students actively participate in STEM activities.</li> <li>Helping students demonstrate their understanding of STEM content.</li> <li>Supporting students to share their ideas and opinions.</li> </ul>
PD Received and Desired	<ul> <li>Do you feel you have enough training/support to lead STEM activities?</li> <li>What kind of STEM-related support would you like to receive?</li> </ul>
Perceptions of Learning & 21st Century skills in Youth	<ul> <li>In your opinion, do you feel your students' levels of confidence in STEM are the same or different because of your school/program?</li> <li>In your opinion, do you feel your students' STEM skills are the same or different because of your school/program?</li> </ul>
