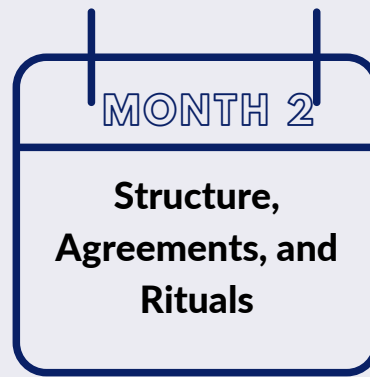

Reimagining Belonging	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reflect on what it feels like to belong and identify the key ingredients of belonging.• Reimagine what belonging could look like in schools/programs.• Evaluate opportunities to build belonging in their school/program.
Structure, Agreements, and Rituals	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understand the components of learning environments that promote belonging.• Name how rituals and agreements create consistency without rigidity.• Brainstorm which components of the learning environment can better build belonging.
Celebrating Identity and Community	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understand how the cultures and identities of educators and youth foster and maintain a community of belonging.• Explore how the alignment of identity and culture within your community influence the sense of belonging.• Design a plan that fosters belonging and community in your school or program.
